**Project of a garden of 4000m<sup>2</sup> near summer house in Strzegowo** – minimal concept for the first year: pathways, grass, several plants. Because of the forest character of the allotment, I proposed using flowering meadow - attractive, not expensive and easy to maintain. Also – a system of low stone walls made out of stones covering the garden. The walls created divisions in perspective and symbolic gates to each part of the garden.

The project included: dendrological inventory (AutoCAD, Excel); general plan with the choice of construction materials and plants; visualisations (Photoshop).

II 2008

**Project of a garden in Falenica (Warsaw, Poland)** – allotment of 600m<sup>2</sup>, close to a pine forest. I made an inventory of the lot and a design in naturalistic style, in which a big number of various native plants makes an impression of wild bush, but it's kept in the strict forms of the plan inspired by yin-yang symbol (AutoCAD, traditional media).
